NOTICE is hereby given that the Albany Unified School District has recirculated a draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) in conjunction with the California Environmental Quality Act for the proposed Albany High School Cougar Field Improvements Project. The project will be located at 1259 Brighton Avenue in the City of Albany, Alameda County and the adjacent field in the City of El Cerrito, Contra Costa County. The proposed project will result in minor demolition, followed by new facilities that include a synthetic field and night lighting.

Potential significant environmental effects discussed in the recirculated draft EIR include land use and planning considerations, visual resources, public services and utilities, traffic and circulation, and noise. Significant and unavoidable impacts identified in the EIR are short-term visual effects during construction, visual effects from Behrens Street/Cougar Field Emergency Driveway, visual effects from Victoria Street/Tahoe Place, visual effects from other locations during nighttime, cumulative effects upon visual resources, cumulative impact on traffic at the intersection of San Pablo Avenue/Carlson Boulevard, parking, the effect of football/soccer and other Cougar Field activities on noise levels at adjacent residences, the effect of noise from the PA system upon adjacent residences, the effect of noise from the field house/concession stand/restroom upon adjacent residences, and cumulative effects upon the noise environment.
