PUBLIC LAW 92-318 OF THE EDUCATION ACT OF 1972

"No person in the United States shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefit of, or be subjected to discrimination under any education program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance."

Proportionality 3 Prong Test

Step # 1

- Student Body Enrollment
 - -51% boys 49% girls
- Athletic Program Participation
 - -51% boys 49% girls

(5% variable) 54%-44% is OK

OR

Proportionality 3 Prong Test

Step # 2

- **♦**History & Expansion
 - Can the school/district show that to increase the number of underrepresented students participating they have added *recent* opportunities.

OR

Proportionality 3 Prong Test

Step # 3

- **♦Full & Effective Accommodation**
 - Can the school/district show that the interests of the female students have been fully and effectively satisfied. Are we meeting their athletic needs?







